28TH FINANCE SECTOR UNION THRIFT & CREDIT & COOPERATIVE LIMITED AGM

Notice is given for 28th FSU Thrift & Credit Co-Op Ltd AGM (pursuant to Clause 54 (1) of the Co-Operatives Act 1996) to be held on **20th June 2026 after or before the Union's AGM.**

Clause 57 (1) serves as the 21 days' notice of this AGM. Notice will also be printed in either The Fiji Times or **the Fiji Sun on 30th May 2026**

Quorum for the AGM (pursuant to Clause 58 (1) (b) of the Co-Operatives Act 1996) will be at least equal to one-fourth of all members or one hundred members, whichever is the less.

If a quorum is not reached, a second AGM shall be convened with the same Agenda within the next 15 days and at this meeting valid decisions may be taken irrespective of the number of members present or represented (pursuant to Clause 58 (2) of the Co-Operatives Act 1996).

All members are requested to come forward and exercise your democratic rights to participate in the Elections process.
